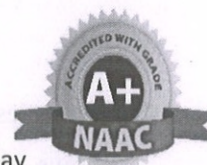

The meeting is held on 9th December 2022 at 1:30 PM Chaired by the SRISHTI Convener & the following Committee members were present.

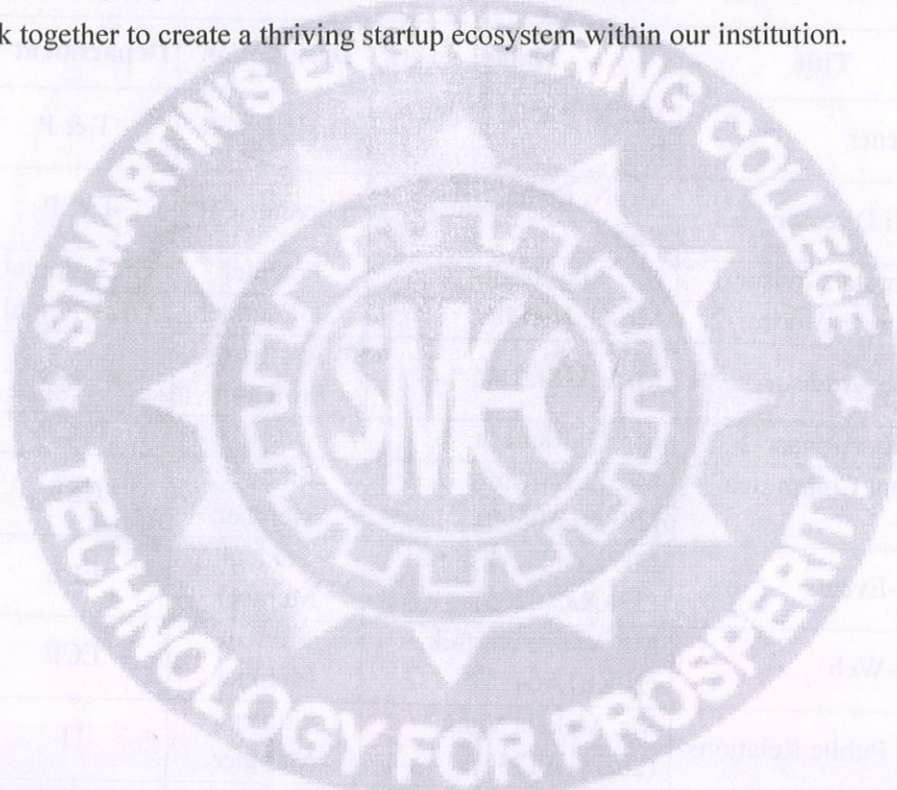
