- 1. Anti-Ragging committee was formed with senior staff members of the college.

 The members have been selected from all the departments.
- 2. The phone numbers of the committee to be displayed across all the departments for students' convenience.
- 3. Phone numbers of Principal, all department heads, management members and local police to be displayed across the college for students' convenience.
- 4. An exclusive block is provided for the I year students to curb the fear of ragging.

- 5. The college maintains separate lunch timings i.e. 11.50A.M.-12.30 P.M. for I years and 12.30P.M. -1.10 P.M. for the II, III, IV year students.
- 6. A special meeting to be conducted for senior students with the local police personnel to remind them of the repercussions of ragging.
- 7. Anti ragging instructions and banners to be displayed at prominent places in the college to create awareness among the students regarding the punishments which would be levied if found guilty.
- 8. The Committee performs surprise checks in probable areas of ragging such as the Bus parking area and at the Canteen premises.
- 9. Students, who come by college transport, are taken special care by marking separate seats for juniors in the front, faculty in the middle and seniors at the end.
- 10. Every College bus has a faculty in-charge, who supervises the students.
- 11. Faculty members are deployed during lunch hours, early morning hours and after college hours to avoid any sort of gathering by students.
- 12. Special care to be taken for the I year students initially to avoid any kind of ragging.
