Maintaining personal hygiene is necessary for reasons such as personal, social, health, psychological as a way of life. Women need to take extra care during the time of their menstrual cycle. The Women Empowerment Team and Street Cause department visited a government school. The team explained the women folk, regarding the care that must be taken during this period of time, why is it so important, what changes they undergo during this phase of adolescence, why is it more safe and hygienic to opt for sanitary napkins over cotton cloth ect.,. At the end of the session, sanitary napkins were distributed and queries were clarified. The end result acquired by our young team members was the sharing of intimate knowledge to the less privileged fellow beings and also the satisfaction derived by making other people happy in a clean environment.

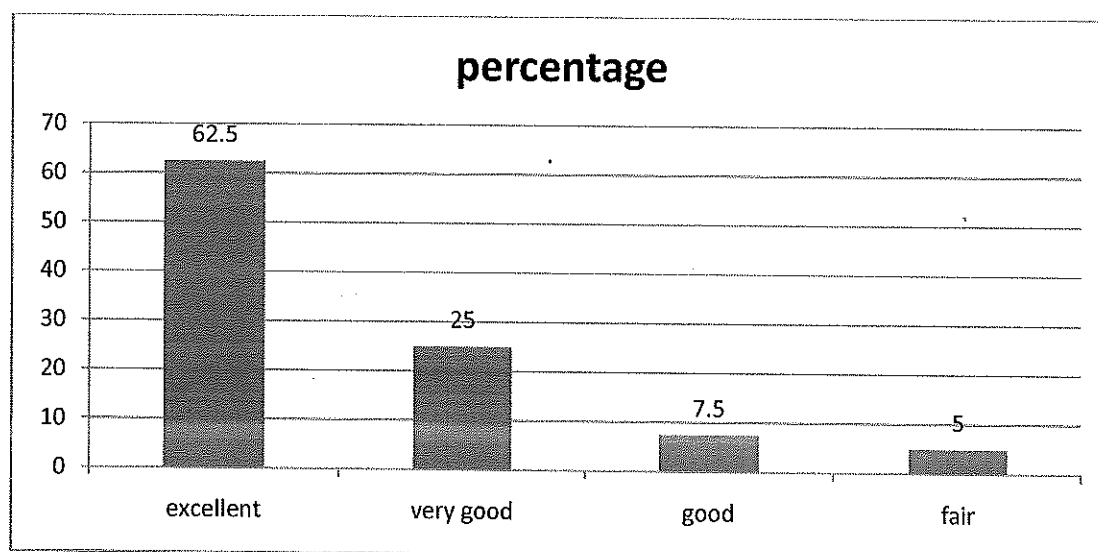
